I. The Word

- A. The Word was in the beginning (John 1:1-3).
 1. (Genesis 1:26)
 2. The Word is part of the Godhead (1 John 5:7).
 3. John the Baptist said that the Word was before him (John 1:15).
- B. The Word became flesh and lived on the Earth (John 1:14).
- C. John saw His glory, the glory of the only Son of God (John 1:14).

II. "But We See Jesus..."

- A. (Hebrews 2:9)
- B. "A little lower than the angels" (Hebrews 2:7,9)
- C. (Philippians 2:5-11)
 1. Verse 6 -- "Being" should better be translated "existing". Christ still exists in the form of God.
 2. Christ became a bondservant, a man of no reputation, He humbled Himself, He was obedient to death on the cross (verses 7-8).
 3. We are to imitate that mind set (verse 5).

III. Put on Christ and Live in the Light

- A. "Shine as lights in the world" (Philippians 2:15)
- B. Let our lights be evidence of the Father (Matthew 5:16).
- C. "You are a light in the Lord" (Ephesians 5:8).
- D. For us to be lights, we have to look to the True Light (John 8:12).
- E. Lovers of truth will come to the light and there actions have been done in God (John 3:21).
- F. Our Savior pleads with you to obey the word.
- G. To have a light you must be in the True Light. Put on Christ today (Galatians 3:27), and begin walking as a light (Ephesians 5:8).

Conclusion:

1. Let those who are in darkness begin anew by hearing, believing, repenting, confessing, and being baptized.
2. The Savior pleads, and so do we.
