

The Great Physician Who Never Lost A Case

(Luke 8:41-48)

I. Somebody Sought A Cure

- A. The woman had a terrible disease for 12 years (Luke 8:43).
 - 1. This Law called for the lady to be withdrawn from the community (Leviticus 15:19-30).
- B. This woman spent “all of her living” on this disease (Luke 8:43).
 - 1. No physician was able to heal her (Luke 8:43).
 - 2. In fact, she got worse (Mark 5:26)

II. Somebody Believed

- A. The faith or belief she had made her well (Luke 8:48)
- B. She knew the if she just touched the edge of the garment she would be made whole. (Matthew 9:21)

III. Somebody Touched The Great Physician

- A. (Luke 8:46)
- B. Jesus knew that someone had touched Him (Luke 8:46).
- C. What did she tell herself she had to touch?
 - 1. Just the hem or border of his garment.

IV. Somebody Was Cured

- A. Whenever the woman touched the hem or border of Christ’s garment she was immediately made well (Luke 8:44; Matthew 9:22; Mark 5:29).
- B. She acted upon her faith and that is what made her well.
 - 1. (James 2:14-26) “Faith without works is dead”

V. Somebody Was Commended

- A. Jesus knew who she was and what she had done (Matthew 9:22; Mark 9:32).
- B. She came to Jesus trembling (Luke 8:47; Mark 5:33).
- C. Jesus calls her “Daughter” (Luke 8:48).

VI. How Does This Apply To Us?

- A. Someone must seek a cure! (Romans 6:23).
- B. Someone must Believe! (Mark 16:16)
- C. Someone must come to the Great Physician! (John 1:29, Matthew 1:21))
- D. Someone will be cured! (Hebrews 9:13, 14; Ephesians 1:7)
- E. Someone will be commended! (Matthew 25:41)
