



# How Do We Evangelize?

(Acts 8:2-4)

*Introduction:*

1. This lesson is not designed to be a complete manuscript on evangelism or evangelism techniques.
2. Tonight, the purpose of this lesson is to provide some suggestion, hints, and Scriptures for better evangelism.

**I. First, Understand There is a Need for Evangelism**

- A. There is going to be a judgement. (Acts 17:31)
- B. Not everyone will go to Heaven:
  1. (Matthew 7:21-23)
  2. (2 Thessalonians 1:7-9)
- C. Sin separates people from God. (Isaiah 59:1, 2)

**II. Second, Realize the Need to Evangelize is our Duty**

- A. (2 Corinthians 5:18-21)
- B. There is the call from above. (Matthew 28:18-20)
- C. There is a call from below. (Luke 16:27-31)
- D. There is a call from the lost. (Acts 16:9)
- E. There is a call from within. (Acts 4:19)
  1. It is the call of the implanted word (James 1:21)

**III. Third, What Can You Do?**

- A. Make a list:
  1. List those you want to tell about the gospel (family, friends, coworkers, neighbors, visitors, etc.).
  2. Give priority to those who are "unchurched."
  3. Pray for those on the list and work for those on the list.
- B. Pray (Romans 10:1; Matthew 9:37-38)
  1. Pray to be able to talk to one person a week.
  2. The Lord will provide opportunities. (2 Corinthians 2:12)
- C. Work out your mind
  1. To help the body grow, you need to grow (2 Peter 3:18).
  2. (1 Peter 3:15)
  3. (2 Timothy 2:19-20)
- D. Get out and labor
  1. The apostles were workers (John 1:35-51)
  2. Confront sin (Acts 2:36)
  3. Relationship evangelism (Luke 5:27-32)
  4. Conversation evangelism (John 4:1-32)
  5. Intellectual evangelism (Acts 17:16-34)
