- 2. He will soon be leaving them, so He comforts them with some thoughts of Heaven.**

I. The Way

- A. Jesus is our example (1 Peter 2:21).**
 - 1. Every word, act, and attitude is worthy of our imitation.**
- B. Jesus is the only way to the Father (John 14:6).**
- C. Jesus is the only way to avoid death (John 8:51)**
- D. Jesus is the only name that we are saved by (Acts 4:11-12).**
- E. He is the only way from God to Man (Ephesians 1:3).**
- F. (John 1:51)**
 - 1. He is our intercessor (Romans 8:34), our mediator (1 Timothy 2:5), and High Priest (Hebrews 4:14-15).**
- G. Christ is the only one who could be the way:**
 - 1. He was sinless (Hebrews 4:12),**
 - 2. He is the Son of God (John 3:16),**
 - 3. He fulfilled the Old Law and took it out of the way (Colossians 2:14).**

II. The Truth

- A. He was full of truth (John 1:14).**
- B. He proclaimed the truth (John 8:45).**
- C. Jesus spoke the things of the Father (John 17:14-17).**
 - 1. The words of the Father are truth (John 17:17).**
 - 2. God cannot lie (Hebrews 6:18).**

III. The Life

- A. Jesus is responsible for physical life (John 1:1-3).**
 - 1. (Colossians 1:16-18)**
- B. Jesus is responsible for everlasting life (John 3:16).**
 - 1. (John 10:10)**
 - 2. (1 John 4:9)**

- 2. We need to follow the way, walking by the truth to have the life.**
